 - What is the impact on nursing homes, home care/hospice and dialysis when a hospital has to rapidly decompress or evacuate?
 - What is the impact on hospitals when the clinics, community mental health centers, and Federally Qualified Health Centers are closed, or when home care is unable to access their patients?
- Comply with CMS by: using the questions provided for further discussion with your internal management; completing your responses and Improvement Plan items; educating your staff.

The November 15, 2017 CMS Compliance deadline is right around the corner. The timing is perfect to work together as a healthcare coalition, looking at how we can support one another during a disaster – true mutual aid.

*For Religious Non-medical Health Care Institutions (RNHCIs) and Organ Procurement Organizations (OPOs), this is the only annual exercise requirement that is in place.
